

# How do I sell games at the Berlin Brettspiel Con Flea Market 2026?

## **IMPORTANT!**

You need a badge or a valid ticket for the day on which you want to do your settlement and take home your unsold games.

To drop off your registered games on Saturday or Sunday, you also need a day ticket (or a badge). For drop-off on Friday before 3:00 PM, no ticket (or badge) is required. If you have a badge, you may also drop off on Friday during the Game Night from 4:30 PM to 7:00 PM.

**The flea market team is not liable for theft or damage to your submitted games. (This also applies during the flea market's closed hours.)**

**Your sales proceeds will not be paid in cash, but will be transferred to your specified bank account within 5 days after the event.**

## **Step 1: Registration**

Game registration takes place via the flea market team's website: [www.brettspiel-flohmarkt.com](http://www.brettspiel-flohmarkt.com)

On the site, you must first register with your email address, a password, and your personal and address details. (Only the registered person may later drop off games and collect the proceeds.) You must also provide your bank details in the form of your IBAN, as well as your planned drop-off time and your estimated settlement time.

To complete your registration, you must accept the terms of sale. **PLEASE READ THESE CAREFULLY.**

After clicking the REGISTER button, you will go directly to the game registration. If you do not want to register your games immediately after signing up, you can log out via LOGOUT in the top right and log back in later using your email and the password you chose during registration.

## **Step 2: Registration of Games**

You can register your games via the GAME REGISTRATION tab.

**Registration deadline is July 2, 2026 at 11:59 PM.**

**Note:** If we reach our capacity limit beforehand, no further registrations will be accepted. The current capacity status will be shown at the top of the page.

To register games, you must have provided your bank details (IBAN), your planned drop-off time, and your estimated settlement time during registration. If you forgot to do this, you can add it under PROFILE.

**For each game you register, you must enter:**

- I. The name of the game and the publisher
- II. The selling price in whole euros
- III. *Optional:* A reduced selling price in whole euros that applies on Sunday if the game was not sold on Saturday. If no Sunday price is entered, the Saturday selling price is used. If you are only dropping off your games on Sunday, enter the selling price again as the Sunday price. (The price

listed for the respective day applies; price negotiations are therefore not possible.)

IV. *Optional*: Notes (also visible on the label later), such as:

- "special edition" / "limited edition" / "Kickstarter exclusive content" / "insert" etc.
- Notes about damaged components / bent rulebooks etc.
- To indicate whether it is a German or English version, a Kickstarter edition, or still factory sealed, you can click the checkboxes (this is intended to save time)

V. The type of game: base game, expansion, bundle (e.g. base game and expansion(s) or with various extras), accessories (e.g. inserts, playmats), promos

VI. Whether the game is playable with 6 or more people

VII. Whether it is a small game whose box surface fits on an A5 sheet

After entering all the data, confirm your entries by clicking "OK." Only then will your entries be saved. You can delete an entry via the "X" button on the right side.

**Note:** You may register a maximum of 56 games. Please note: only complete games • no played (altered) legacy games • no used games where components are necessarily damaged (e.g. EXIT games by Kosmos) • expansions sold individually each count as one game • base games that include expansions count as one game (bundle)

## Label Printing

You will find the "Show labels" button at the bottom right. Labels contain: game name, sorting letters, Saturday/Sunday price, seller number, game number, game type, and your notes.

### Printing options:

- Self-adhesive **removable** label paper
- Plain paper, cut out and attach with masking tape
- Save as PDF and print later

**Use 100% scaling and print without margins. Do NOT stick the label on the bottom of the box — use the shorter long side. Recommend printing labels twice (once for each side).**

## Step 3: Drop-Off

You must personally drop off your labeled games, either:

- **Friday, July 10, 2026** from 12:00 PM to 3:00 PM (and additionally 4:30–7:00 PM with a badge for the GameNight)
- **Saturday (July 11)** and **Sunday (July 12, 2026)** during opening hours

### Flea Market Opening Hours (subject to change):

**Important for drop-off:** For each game, you must pay a **listing fee of €0.50** — payable at settlement, not at drop-off. **The listing fee is payable even if a game is not sold!**

Secure each game so lid/contents cannot fall out (use removable masking tape or rubber bands for small games). Do NOT use stretch wrap.

## Step 4: Settlement (Sales Proceeds and Collection)

**A day ticket (or badge) is required for the settlement.**

Come to the GAME DROP-OFF / INFO desk with a valid photo ID and your seller number.

Settlement Times (subject to change)	
Saturday, July 11, 2026:	6:00 PM – 7:00 PM
Sunday, July 12, 2026:	4:00 PM – 6:00 PM (end of Berlin Brettspiel Con)

**Note:** Unsold games not collected and settlements not made by **Sunday, July 12, 2026 at 6:00 PM** will be treated as donations!

**At settlement, a listing fee of €0.50 per submitted game and a sales commission per sold game will be deducted:**

Selling price	€1–5	€6–20	€21–40	€41–60	€61–100	€100+
Commission	€1.00	€1.50	€2.50	€3.50	€5.50	€7.00

*Example: A game sold for €41 → €0.50 (listing fee) + €3.50 (commission) = €4.00 deducted. You receive €37.00.*

**Proceeds are transferred to your bank account within 5 days after the event. Settlement must be done in person on-site. Settlement after the event is not possible. Only one final settlement is possible.**

## Terms of Sale

- The flea market team is not liable for submitted games (loss or damage, including during closed hours).
- Registration deadline: Thursday, July 2, 2026. Only pre-registered games are accepted on-site.
- Each game has a fixed Saturday price and an optional reduced Sunday price. No other price changes are possible.
- Games must arrive already labeled. Labeling on-site is not possible!
- The flea market team reserves the right to refuse games.
- The team may delay displaying games due to space constraints, or not display them due to poor condition discovered after submission. The listing fee is still due.
- Transport assistance (e.g. from car to drop-off) is NOT available.
- Boxes/bags handed over at drop-off may not be returnable.

- Listing fee is offset against sales proceeds at settlement.
- Listing fee is due even if the game is not sold.
- Sales commission depends on selling price (see table above).
- Payment by bank transfer within 5 days after the event. Bank account required.
- The person who registered and submitted the games must sign to confirm proceeds and IBAN accuracy.
- Schedule changes are possible and will be announced.
